Is the suspect in the evidence? A match between the victim's neck and the suspect is: 41.9 trillion times more probable than a coincidental match to an unrelated African-American person 8.45 trillion times more probable than a coincidental match to an unrelated Caucasian person 1.75 trillion times more probable than a coincidental match to an unrelated Hispanic person

Case outcome

Prosecutor submitted the case to Cybergenetics via free screening offer

Cybergenetics sent the prosecutor preliminary results in 2 weeks

Prosecutor told Cybergenetics 3 weeks later that the suspect pled guilty
